The first Messy Church began in 2004 (under the guidance of Lucy Moore) when a group at St Wilfrid's in Cowplain near Portsmouth, England, were frustrated because, as a church, they were hardly reaching any children with God's story.

They felt they had lovely buildings and facilities but weren't using them enough. They had creative people in the church, and the area needed as much community-building as possible.

So they decided very early on to try to do something for all ages together, partly out of a belief that we grow best as a church when we walk the journey with as many different people as possible, and partly from a desire to help families to grow together in their walk of faith.
